SAN DIMAS HIGH SCHOOL DANCE REGULATIONS

Dress for dances will be in keeping with that type of dance. Any change in acceptable wear will be advertised prior to the dance. Students who are not dressed appropriately will be sent home to correct their attire or asked to wear PE clothes during the dance.

Boys Dress: Boys are expected to follow school dress code.

Girls Dress: Girls are expected to follow school dress code.

The following dress attire is inappropriate:

- See-through fabrics
- Open sides
- Slits above mid-thigh
- Attire that reveals breasts, bottoms and/or belly buttons. This means there must be actual fabric between the breasts, not see through fabric.

Girls who choose not to follow the above polices will be asked to put on a t-shirt over the dress and must wear it as long as they are in attendance at the dance.

Students must bring their San Dimas High School I.D. card to gain admittance to the dance and all guests must also provide a picture I.D. Students must remain inside or within specified areas once they have arrived. Once a student leaves the dance, the student cannot return.

Students are expected to follow school rules and the Code of Conduct at all dances. Rules about smoking and drinking apply at every dance, including those held off campus. The administration will use a breathalyzer or similar instrument to test students that appear to be under the influence of any controlled substance. Administration may use the breathalyzer on the student at any point during the dance. Students who fail the test at any point during the dance, are not issued a refund of the dance ticket. They will be held until released to the custody of their parents and/or police, and will be subject to disciplinary actions under the discipline code of San Dimas High School. Student will be ineligible to attend the next school dance.

A San Dimas HS student may bring a guest to the dance provided the following rules are followed:

- **A guest pass is required, and must be applied for and approved via administration by the last day of ticket sales.** Copy of ID must be provided by the student.
- If high school age, the guest must be enrolled in school, and the guest's school must be able to provide information about the guest. Only guests who have finished high school and are 20 years old or younger are permitted. Guests must stay with the SDHS student throughout the event.
- Guests must understand that they are attending a high school event, and that they are required to follow San Dimas High School rules.

San Dimas High School Dancing Guidelines (Applies on and off the dance floor)

Students will be provided a bracelet to wear during the dance. If the Dancing Guidelines are not followed, the student's bracelet will receive a hole punch. If a student is not following the Dancing Guidelines a second time (bracelet has already been punched), the student will be escorted off the dance floor, parents will be called and students will be asked to leave the dance, and will be ineligible to attend the next school dance or senior activity. No refunds will be given if you are asked to leave.

DANCING GUIDELINES

- **No straddling legs, bending over or lap dancing**
- **No “grinding”**
- **No “making out” or no overt and or prolonged public displays of affection**
- **No touching breasts, buttocks or genitals**
- **Hands may touch waists, backs or shoulders only**
- **Both feet must remain on the floor**
- **No Dancing in which movements imply sexual actions with person or with objects**

In the case of a dance held in an aquatic setting, I understand that my son/daughter must get there on time so that the boat may leave at the departure time. If they miss the departure time I understand that there are no refunds.

If students take group transportation which includes but is not limited to limousine, bus, etc., it will/may be searched at any point while the vehicle is on the event property.

PARENT NOTIFICATION & REFUND POLICY:

Under the provisions of Education Code 1081.5, all persons attending shall be deemed to have waived all claims against the district or the State of California for injury, accident, illness or death occurring during or by reason of the activity.

I hereby give the school permission to contact me should my son/daughter violate school directives including the school dancing policy or participate in drinking or drugs. I also accept the responsibility of going to the **dance location** to take custody of my son/daughter in the event that I am called by school personnel.

My signature testifies to the fact that I have read and understand the above statements and waive all claims as indicated and that I accept the responsibility of going to the **dance location** to pick up my son/daughter if so required.

REFUNDS WILL NOT BE GIVEN FOR ANY REASON. TICKETS ARE NOT EXCHANGABLE. ALL TRANSACTIONS MUST GO THROUGH THE FINANCE OFFICE. All students need to take care of all disciplinary/finance issues before the time the dance begins in order to enter the dance, even if they have already been sold a ticket. If a dance ticket has been sold and the student earns a Saturday School they must serve it before the dance and bring the signed paper that shows they served or they cannot attend and no refunds will be given.
