### Conditions for Off-Campus Lunch Application:

1. Juniors and Seniors are eligible for a lunch pass only during quarters in which they have earned an extended lunch.
2. Qualified Juniors and Seniors will be issued an off-campus lunch pass only upon receipt of this authorization form signed by their parent(s) or guardian(s).
3. Students are expected to follow the San Dimas High School standards of behavior during the lunch period off campus. Violation of school rules will result in disciplinary action and/or loss of lunch pass.
4. Students with a valid card in hand will be checked at the assigned exit by a staff member. Students leaving the campus without going through the assigned exit will lose their off-campus lunch passes.
5. Transportation of unauthorized students is prohibited, and the driver will lose his/her lunch pass. All California licensing laws must be observed.
6. Students are not to visit other schools or interfere in any way with mid-day community activities during lunch period.
7. Students must park vehicles in the student parking lot and such vehicles must be registered with the State of California and have a San Dimas High School Parking Permit.
8. When students are requested to show their off-campus permits and/or I.D., they are to cooperate without delay. Failure to comply will result in loss of privilege.
9. Students are required to return punctually and regularly from lunch to sixth period class.
10. Lunch passes can be revoked at anytime due to discipline or attendance issues.
11. Any student who allows another student to use his/her lunch pass or uses a forged or borrowed lunch pass will lose his/her pass for the remainder of the year.
  - **Students who fail to return to campus for any reason must have a parent call before sixth period is over; otherwise, the student is truant.**
  - **If the student is unable to contact a parent, the student must call and have the parent call and/or send a note the following day.**
  - **If this occurs more than once during the school year, the student's lunch pass privileges will be suspended.**

**Conditions for Temporary Exception to Policy – Pursuant to Section 13557.7 of the Education Code (SB 241, Mills), governing boards are authorized to permit high school pupils to leave school grounds during their lunch period. The Code specifies that neither the District nor its officers or employees are financially liable for the conduct or safety of the pupils during that time.**
