

San Dimas High School Saint Fund Program

- What is the Saint Fund Program? It is a way for parents to donate discretionary funds directly to their student's classroom for use during the current school year. The Saint Fund gives our teachers the ability to buy additional supplies and tools for their classroom.
- How do I make my contribution? Simply fill out the Saint Fund donation form and enclose it with your check, made out to San Dimas High School PTSA. You may use the Saint Fund donation form which can be found in the Main Office or go to SanDimasHigh.com, "PTSA/Car Show", "PTSA Store", "Donate to Saint's Fund".
- How are the funds disbursed? All purchases made are for their classroom use only and becomes property of the school. They can turn in receipts for qualifying items and be reimbursed by the Saint Fund. In the unlikely event that there is a small balance left in a teacher's fund at the end of the year, that amount will be transferred to the PTSA general fund.
- **May I make additional contributions at a later time?** Absolutely! Donations are <u>always</u> <u>appreciated</u>. We try to offer our teachers the benefit of purchasing items at the beginning of the year, but you may donate any time. It makes a great teacher gift for the holidays.
- May I write one check for donations to more than one classroom? Yes, just indicate on the form how much goes to which classroom.
- Donations are tax deductible.
