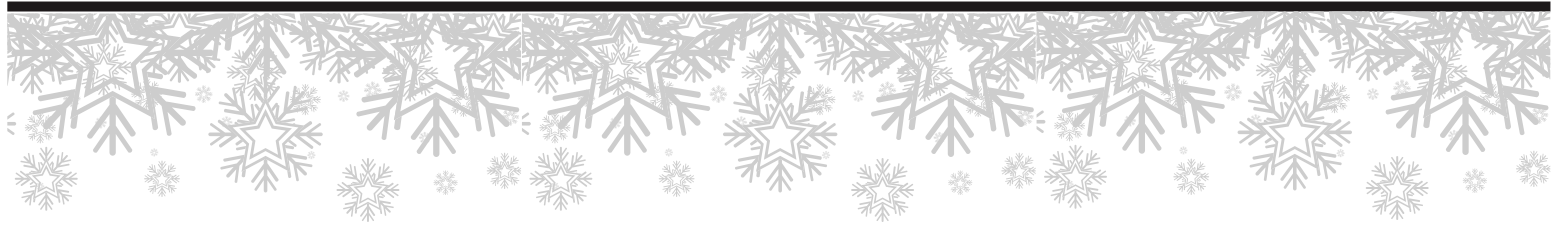

FAFSA Workshop

Wednesday, January 25th 6-8pm

Seniors & Parents - If you haven't yet completed your FAFSA application, please attend this hands-on workshop. We will have college financial aid reps to help you complete this important step in your student's post-high school journey.

Please bring along the following info and documents:

1. If you have a Social Security Number (not issued through DACA), please create an FSA ID prior to the appointment by clicking [here](#).
 - a. Use your full legal name (as printed on your Social Security card) and write down your username, password, and security question answers.
2. If one of your parents has a Social Security Number (not issued through DACA), ask your parent to create an [FSA ID](#) with their own information.
3. If you have DACA or do not have a Social Security number, please click here create your [CADAA](#) login.
4. It's helpful if your parent(s) can also attend the workshop; however, if they are not able to do so, please have the following information:
 - Parent and student 2020 Income Tax return(s) & 2020 W-2(s) (if applicable)
 - Parent's marital status (single, married/remarried, divorced/separated, or widowed)
 - Parent(s) marital status date (MM/DD/YYYY)
 - Parent(s) and student social security number (if applicable)
 - Parent(s) first and last name
 - Parent(s) date of birth (MM/DD/YYYY)
