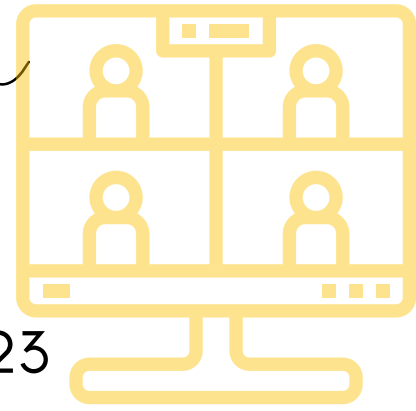

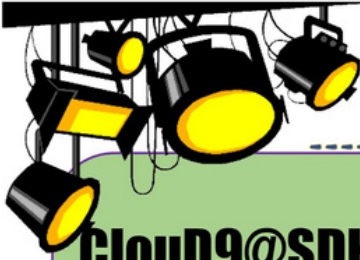


## *Join the San Dimas Saints Bingo Committee*

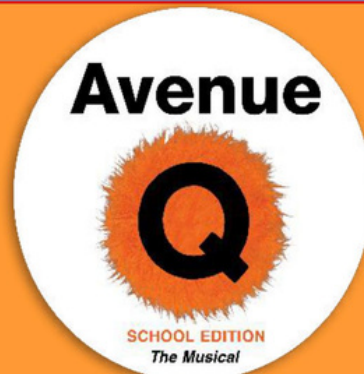

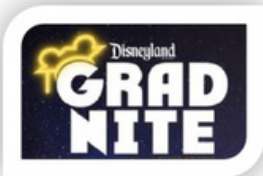
